We are well settled back after the Christmas period and look forward to a healthy and busy 2022.

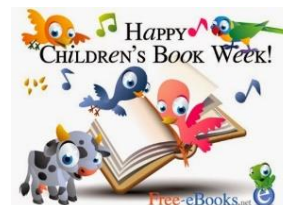
